

VOLUNTEER APPLICATION PROCESS



1. VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

If you are interested in volunteering with Scotty's House, please submit a completed Volunteer Application. Not sure if our volunteer program is right for you? You are welcome to attend a New Volunteer Orientation to find out more.

2. NEW VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION

All volunteers must attend New Volunteer Orientation prior to serving in any capacity with our agency. Any interested applicants are welcome to attend orientation and are under no obligation to volunteer if they decide the program is not right for them. We offer New Volunteer Orientation three times a year, in spring, summer, and fall.

3. VOLUNTEER INTERVIEW

After you have attended the New Volunteer Orientation and submitted a completed application, our volunteer coordinator will contact you to schedule a time for an interview. During the interview, you will be given the Background Check Authorization Form.

4. VOLUNTEER FILE REVIEW

After you have completed both the orientation and interview, and we receive the results from your background check, your file is reviewed and we will notify you via email or phone of your acceptance into the Volunteer Program.

5. ADDITIONAL TRAINING

Family Care volunteers (FCs) and Medical Accompaniment Volunteers (MAVs) are required to attend additional training prior to serving in these roles with our agency. FC and MAV trainings are offered twice a year, in spring and fall.
